The Architects Registration Council of Nigeria (ARCON) was set up in 1989 to regulate the training and practice of the Architectural profession by the Architects (Registration, Etc) Act A19 Laws of the Federation of Nigeria 2004.

This programme holds in April and November each year as approved by the Council.

- 1. REQUIREMENTS:
1. Minimum of two years supervised post-qualification practice between date of graduation as indicated on post-graduate certificate and October 2017.
2. Prospective candidates with foreign qualifications must ensure that their degrees qualify for full registration by the professional regulatory body in the country of origin.
3. Prospective candidates in all cases must be Nigerians and must be currently resident in Nigeria and also currently fully involved in the practice of Architecture under the supervision of an architect who is financial and fully registered to practice architecture in Nigeria with a minimum of five (5) years post-registration experience.
II. METHOD OF APPLICATION - Applications must fall under only ONE of any of the categories as stated below.
a. FRESH APPLICATIONS
1. Download and fully fill the ARCON ACP Application Forms from the ARCON website- www.arconigeria.org.ng
2. Recent coloured passport photograph taken against a white background scanned and affixed against the application form.
3. Scanned copies of all relevant educational certificates. All applicants must have their certificates sighted and endorsed by a member of current ARCON Council.
i. WASC/WAEC or equivalent certificates. Statement of results are not accepted.
ii. B.Sc./B.Tech./B.E.S. (Arch) and M.Sc./M.Tech./M.E.D (Arch) or their equivalent degrees
iii. NYSC Participation or Exemption certificates.
4. Affidavit for discrepancies in names or other particulars (if any) on certificates.
5. Non-Refundable Application fee of N2,500,000 (Two Thousand Five Hundred Naira only). This is not the programme fee. Only eligible candidates will be allowed to pay for the Programme Fee.
b. REFERRED APPLICATIONS - Applicants who had earlier successfully pre-qualified for the ACP 1.0 but did not proceed with the programme.
1. Download and fill ARCON ACP1/ARP Application /002
2. Attach a copy of your ACP Application Letter earlier mailed to you from ARCON. Your application letter indicates your programme number as proof of pre-qualification.
3. Stage Two Fee N30,000.00 (Thirty Thousand Naira only).
c. REFERRED CANDIDATES - Candidates with references in previous ARCON ACP1
1. Download and fill ARCON ACP1/ARP Application /002
2. Attach a copy of your ACP1/ARP Application Letter earlier mailed to you from ARCON. Your application letter indicates your programme number as proof of pre-qualification.
3. Appropriate fee details available in ARCON ACP1/ARP Application/ 002 form

ARCON REGULARISATION PROGRAMME ARP 2018

The Architects Registration Council of Nigeria (ARCON) was set up in 1989 to regulate the training and practice of the Architectural profession by the Architects (Registration, Etc) Act A19 Laws of the Federation of Nigeria 2004.

The ARP is a special one-off programme designed by ARCON to clear the backlog of persons who have not been deemed eligible for their professional registrations due to the following:

- 1. Candidates with either B.Sc./B.Tech./B.E.S. (Arch) and/or M.Sc./M.Tech./M.E.D (Arch) or their equivalent degrees of unaccredited Architecture programme from Nigerian schools;
2. Candidates who graduated from Nigerian schools with unaccepted degree nomenclature in Architecture. In view of the regulatory powers conferred on ARCON by the Act, applications are invited from graduates of Architecture up until December 31, 2015 who fall under any of the categories stated above to remedy their deficiencies through the ARCON Regularisation Programme
This is a FINAL mop-off exercise.

1. THOSE WHO MAY APPLY:
1. Unaccredited B.Sc./B.Tech./B.E.S. (Arch) + Accredited M.Sc./M.Tech./M.E.D (Arch) or their equivalent degrees in Architecture programme from Nigerian schools;
2. Accredited B.Sc./B.Tech./B.E.S. (Arch) + Unaccredited M.Sc./M.Tech./M.E.D (Arch) or their equivalent degrees in Architecture programme from Nigerian schools;
3. Unaccredited B.Sc./B.Tech./B.E.S. (Arch) + Unaccredited M.Sc./M.Tech./M.E.D (Arch) or their equivalent degrees of in Architecture programme from Nigerian schools.

2. Recent coloured passport photograph taken against a white background scanned and affixed against the application form.

i. WASC/WAEC or equivalent certificates. Statement of results are not accepted.
ii. B.Sc./B.Tech./B.E.S. (Arch) and M.Sc./M.Tech./M.E.D (Arch) or their equivalent degrees
iii. NYSC Participation or Exemption certificates.
4. Affidavit for discrepancies in names or other particulars (if any) on certificates.
5. Non-Refundable Application fee of N2,500,000 (Two Thousand Five Hundred Naira only). This is not the programme fee. Only eligible candidates will be allowed to pay for the Programme Fee.
b. PREQUALIFIED APPLICATIONS - Applicants who had earlier successfully pre-qualified for the ARP but did not proceed with the programme.

2. Attach a copy of your ARP Application Letter earlier mailed to you from ARCON. Your application letter indicates your programme number as proof of pre-qualification.
3. Programme Fee N70,000.00 (Seventy Thousand Naira only).
